1. Final exams for grades 7-8 will count as a unit test. Final exams for grades 9-11 count for 10% of the semester grade.
2. Concurrent Credit program requirements dictate a two-hour final exam period for CC courses. CC courses are taught in periods 1, 2, and 5.

4. All G7-11 final exams will be administered at LCS.

**Check Out Forms** – Forms are to being distributed today.

**Step 1:** Turn in books and get the teacher's initials indicating that you turned in your books. Teachers will indicate if there is a fee for damage or loss. If there is a fee indicated on the form, you will need to pay it during step 3 at the office.

**Step 2:** Lockers must be cleaned out, then checked and signed off by the period teacher indicated on the form.

**Step 3:** The office secretaries will verify and sign off on the parking pass (parking passes must be returned or there is a \$5 fee), lunch account, sport fee and sport uniform sections.
